TOURNAMENT FORMAT & RULES

The decision of the Tournament Committee in all matters relating to the tournament is final.

- Handicap confirmation must be produced when checking in on Monday if asked for. It is the duty of
 each competitor to notify his exact handicap to the tournament desk before commencing the Monday
 qualifying round.
- Competitors should report to the desk at least 20 minutes before their tee off time each time they are playing.
- The 2 qualifying rounds will be based on Playing Handicap

All competitors will play two qualifying rounds, one on Monday and one on Tuesday. The tee time will be identical on both days. In the event of loss of qualifying days due to bad weather, qualifying will be extended to Wednesday with the number of qualifiers in each section reduced as required.

- The leading 32 Scratch and best 64 aggregate scores will proceed to match play.
- **FULL** difference will apply to all Handicap match play ties
- For qualifying purposes only the sections will be 0-9 and 10-20.

The Match play draws will take place in the Clubhouse at approximately 9:30 p.m. on Tuesday night.

Any player who knows he will be unable to compete in the Matchplay must indicate this on the notice on the board in the foyer no later than 8.00 p.m. on Tuesday and thus not proceed into the match play stages.

All non-qualifiers from the qualifying rounds will be entered into the Consolation Stableford on Wednesday and the draw will be posted after the match play draw. All non-qualifiers from the qualifying rounds together with those competitors defeated in the first round of match play competition may enter the Three Ball on **Thursday**.

Entry sheets will be posted on Wednesday morning at 10.00 a.m.

Note: Those beaten on Thursday morning are not eligible.

A Two Ball Foursomes will be played on Friday between 9.14 a.m. and 12.00 noon. Entry sheets will be posted on Thursday morning, with entries closing at 5.00 p.m. Times will be allocated by the Committee.

During the match play stages, all match play ties will take priority. The 5 Day Committee will make every effort to keep to the schedule but cannot accept responsibility for delays in consolation competitions.

Handicap revision will take place as follows:

- (a) For Match play stages after the second qualifying round Course Handicap will apply
- (b) Consolation Competitions after the 2nd qualifying round and after each Consolation Competition.
- (c) Rule 19 will not be applied during the Tournament.
- (d) Handicaps will only be revised after the 2 Qualifying rounds.
- (e) The Committee has made every effort to ensure that handicaps have been adjusted appropriately, but remind you that every player is ultimately responsible for monitoring his own handicap and must do accordingly.

LIGHTNING

It can be extremely scary being caught far from the Clubhouse when a thunderstorm strikes. Here are some tips on how to minimise the danger:

1. BE AWARE—Be alert to the signs of changing weather, such as darkening skies, a sudden wind shift or drop in temperature. **Do not ignore instructions to get to safety.**

2. PLAN AHEAD—Plan your evacuation and safety measures in advance. Lightning often precedes rain, so do not wait for the rain to begin before suspending activities.

3. SEEK SAFETY—Use the 30-30 rule: at the very latest, seek safety when thunder and lightning are separated by 30 seconds (when the storm will be 5-6 miles away), and do not resume activities for 30 minutes after the last observed lightning or thunder (when the storm has passed 10-15 miles away).

4. IF CAUGHT OUTDOORS - Avoid water. Avoid high ground. Avoid open spaces.

Put down your Clubs, and avoid contact with anything that contains metal, including golf bags, golf carts, umbrellas, electric wires or fences. <u>Open golf carts do not afford safety.</u>

5. AVOID TREES—Do not stand underneath a natural lightning rod such as an isolated tree. Move away from any tree to a distance that is twice the height of the tree.

6. IF LIGHTNING IS STRIKING NEARBY when you are outside, you should:

- Crouch down with your feet together. Do not lie down.
- Place your hands over ears to minimise hearing damage from thunder.
- Avoid proximity to other people keep at least 15 feet apart.
- Do not huddle together.
